- Lectors: 1 corsage and 1 boutonniere of red and orange carnations.

- Mom: Large corsage of red, orange, and white carnations.
- Dad: Boutonniere of red and orange carnations. Herb will pick them up in the sacristy and present to parents for Dave.
- Altar Flowers: Large 48" floral for in front of altar. 2 bouquets, one for each side of tabernacle. All done in red, orange, and white with greens. Long stem color flowers.


